2 **TITLE V—MISCELLANEOUS**

3 **SEC. 501. AMENDMENT TO CHILDREN'S HEALTH ACT OF**

4 **2000.**

5 Section 1004 of the Children's Health Act of 2000

6 (42 U.S.C. 285g note) is amended—

7 (1) in subsection (b), by striking "Agency" and

8 inserting "Agency, and the Department of Edu-

9 cation"; and

1 (2) in subsection (c)—

2 (A) in paragraph (2), by striking “and”  
3 after the semicolon;

4 (B) in paragraph (3), by striking the pe-  
5 riod at the end and inserting “; and”; and

6 (C) by adding at the end the following:

7 “(4) be conducted in compliance with section  
8 444 of the General Education Provisions Act (20  
9 U.S.C. 1232g), including the requirement of prior  
10 parental consent for the disclosure of any education  
11 records, except without the use of authority or ex-  
12 ceptions granted to authorized representatives of the  
13 Secretary of Education for the evaluation of Feder-  
14 ally-supported education programs or in connection  
15 with the enforcement of the Federal legal require-  
16 ments that relate to such programs.”.
