AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mr. REID

Viz:

1 At the end of subtitle D of title VI, add the following:

*PENDING*

1 **SEC. 642. REPEAL OF PHASE-IN OF CONCURRENT RECEIPT**  
2 **OF RETIRED PAY AND VETERANS' DISABILITY**  
3 **COMPENSATION FOR VETERANS WITH SERV-**  
4 **ICE-CONNECTED DISABILITIES RATED AS 100**  
5 **PERCENT.**

6 Section 1414 of title 10, United States Code, is  
7 amended—

8 (1) in subsection (a)(1)—

9 (A) by inserting after the first sentence the  
10 following new sentence: “During the period be-  
11 ginning on January 1, 2004, and ending on De-  
12 cember 31, 2004, payment of retired pay to  
13 such a qualified retiree described in subsection  
14 (c)(1)(B) is subject to subsection (c).”; and

15 (B) in the last sentence, by inserting  
16 “(other than a qualified retiree covered by the  
17 preceding sentence)” after “such a qualified re-  
18 tiree”; and

19 (2) in subsection (c)—

20 (A) in paragraph (1)—

21 (i) in subparagraph (A), by inserting  
22 “(other than a retiree described by sub-  
23 paragraph (B))” after “the retiree”;

24 (ii) by redesignating subparagraphs  
25 (B) through (F) as subparagraphs (C)  
26 through (G), respectively; and

1 (iii) by inserting after subparagraph

2 (A) the following new subparagraph (B):

3 “(B) For a month for which the retiree re-  
4 ceives veterans’ disability compensation for a  
5 disability rated as 100 percent, \$750.”;

6 (B) by redesignating paragraph (11) as  
7 paragraph (12); and

8 (C) by inserting after paragraph (10) the  
9 following new paragraph (11):

10 “(11) INAPPLICABILITY TO VETERANS WITH  
11 DISABILITIES RATED AS 100 PERCENT AFTER CAL-  
12 ENDAR YEAR 2004.—This subsection shall not apply  
13 to a qualified retiree described by paragraph (1)(B)  
14 after calendar year 2004.”.
