AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mr. KENNEDY (for himself, Mr. LEAHY, Mr. DAYTON, and Mr. FEINGOLD)

Viz:

- 1 On page 247, between lines 13 and 14, insert the fol-
- 2 lowing:
- 3 **SEC. 1022. REPORT ON THE STABILIZATION OF IRAQ.**
- 4 (a) INITIAL REPORT.—Not later than 30 days after
- 5 the date of the enactment of this Act, the President shall
- 6 submit to the congressional defense committees an unclas-

1 sified report (with classified annex, if necessary) on the
2 strategy of the United States for stabilizing Iraq. The re-
3 port shall, at a minimum, contain a detailed explanation
4 of the strategy together with the following information:

5 (1) A description of the efforts of the President
6 to work with the United Nations and the North At-
7 lantic Treaty Organization to assist the nearly
8 140,000 members of the Armed Forces of the
9 United States who were serving in Iraq as of June
10 2004, including efforts to ensure that—

11 (A) more military forces of other countries
12 are deployed to Iraq;

13 (B) more police forces of other countries
14 are deployed to Iraq; and

15 (C) more financial resources of other coun-
16 tries are provided for the stabilization and re-
17 construction of Iraq.

18 (2) As a result of such efforts—

19 (A) a list of the countries that have com-
20 mitted to deploying military and police forces;

21 (B) with respect to each such country, the
22 schedule and level of such deployments;

23 (C) a list of the countries that have com-
24 mitted to providing financial resources for the
25 stabilization and reconstruction of Iraq; and

1 (D) with respect to each country that has
2 committed to providing such financial re-
3 sources, the level of, and the schedule for pro-
4 viding, such assistance.

5 (3) A description of the efforts of the President
6 to develop the police and military forces of Iraq to
7 assist the nearly 140,000 members of the Armed
8 Forces of the United States who were serving in
9 Iraq as of June 2004.

10 (4) As a result of such efforts—

11 (A) the number of members of the police
12 and military forces of Iraq that have been re-
13 cruited;

14 (B) the number of members of the police
15 and military forces of Iraq that have been
16 trained; and

17 (C) the number of members of the police
18 and military forces of Iraq that have been de-
19 ployed.

20 (5) A description of the anticipated United
21 States military force posture in the region during
22 the next year, including an estimate of—

23 (A) the number of members of the Armed
24 Forces that will be required to serve in Iraq
25 during the next year;

1 (B) the number of members of the Armed
2 Forces that will be serving in Iraq as of Decem-
3 ber 31, 2005; and

4 (C) the percentage of such forces that will
5 be composed of members of the National Guard
6 and Reserves.

7 (6) A description of the efforts of the United
8 States, Coalition forces, and the people of Iraq to as-
9 sist in the reconstruction of essential infrastructure,
10 including the oil industry, electricity generation ca-
11 pabilities, roads, schools, and hospitals, in Iraq.

12 (7) A description of the efforts of the United
13 States, Coalition forces, relevant international agen-
14 cies, pro-democracy organizations, and the people of
15 Iraq to assist in the development of political institu-
16 tions and prepare for democratic elections in Iraq.

17 (b) UPDATED REPORTS.—The President shall submit
18 to the congressional defense committees an unclassified re-
19 port (with classified annex, if necessary) that describes the
20 strategy of the United States for stabilizing Iraq and up-
21 dates the information required under subsection (a)—

22 (1) not later than 180 days after the date of
23 the enactment of this Act; and

24 (2) not later than one year after the date of the
25 enactment of this Act.
