Dear Senator Leahy:

I am in receipt of your letter dated October 19, 2005, requesting a supplement to my responses to the Senate Judiciary Committee questionnaire, and will work to provide additional materials to the Committee. In the meantime, I am writing to inform the Committee that after submitting the questionnaire yesterday, I became aware that, as a result of an administrative oversight, my Texas Bar license was administratively suspended from September 1 to September 26, 1989, due to late payment of my bar dues. The administrative suspension was lifted as soon as my dues were received, and I understand I was restored to former status.
